SUBJECT: - **IN-PERSON COURSE ON "SUPPLY-CHAIN RESILIENCE" TO BE CONDUCTED IN SINGAPORE FROM 10<sup>th</sup> TO 14<sup>th</sup> JUNE, 2024 UNDER THE JAPAN-SINGAPORE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME FROM THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY (JSPP21)**

The Economic Affairs Division vide its O.M No.4 (9) SEA/2024 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2024 has informed that the Government of Singapore and Japan have invited Two(02) nominations for the above (fully funded) training course. The objectives and eligibility criteria of the subject course are as under:-

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Be Government employees (BS-17 and above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department involved in developing strategies and implementing policies on supply chain resilience for their country;
- Nominated by their respective Government;
- Proficient in written and spoken English;
- In good health.

**Objective:**

- This programme will discuss the impact of recent major events on global supply chains, and share our approach in strengthening supply chain resilience
