**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Permanent Government Officers (BS-17 and above).
- Mid to senior level Officers involved in Islamic finance or in the financial industry.
- Age between 26-50 years old.
- Should have experience of 2-3 years of working experience in the financial industry.
- Should possess a good command of written and spoken English.
- Good health, physically and mentally in order to complete the course.

**Note:-** "In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all Officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings / inquiry is in progress, may need not to apply".
