Subject:- **Training Programme on “Capacity Building for Efficient Management, Disposal and Development of State Properties” to be held from August 26 to 15 September, 2018 at Seoul, Korea**

In pursuance of Economic Affairs Division’s O.M No.2(35)SEA/Korea/ 2018 dated 21-06-2018, interested officers of Finance Division are requested to furnish their nominations for the above training programme at Seoul, Korea duly recommended by the AFS/head of the Wing concerned along with FTC Proforma and copy of CNIC to QA-I Section by **03-07-2018**. Eligibility Criteria:-

Mandatory

- i) Be Government Officers(BS-17 and above) only and nominated by respective Federal Government involved in state property management;
- ii) Be in good health both physical and mentally, enough to take the course;
- iii) Have not participated in the same or similar KOICA fellowship program for the past 3 years-unless otherwise specified;
- iv) Minimum level of work experience: 3-5 years;
- v) Sufficient proficiency in written and spoken English to actively participate in seminars and write an Action Plan


Preferable

Working knowledge of PC and MS Office software;
Working knowledge of state property IT system and public asset disposition system(if there is any)

Objectives

- To understand Korea's achievement and current status in the area of overall State Property management system.
- To ensure efficient management and administration of state properties of the recipient governments through the sharing of Korea exemplary cases in the areas of state property management, disposition and development.
- To help increase government incomes by increasing values of state-owned properties.
- To investigate whether AMCO's proprietary state property management IT system and online public asset disposition system (onbid) can be applied to the recipient governments' IT system.

Note:- “In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress, may need not to apply”
