## Subject: - NOMINATIONS FOR EXPERT POSITIONS ON THE PANEL OF EXPERTS ON YEMEN.

Ministry of Foreign Affairs vide its U.O No. UN (1)-2/3/2023 dated 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2023 on the subject cited above. It is stated that the secretariat of the United Nations presents its compliments to the Permanent Missions of Member States to the United Nations and invites Member States to recommend qualified individuals to serve on the Panel of Experts established pursuant to resolution 2140(2014) on Yemen, and extended by resolution 2675 (2023), subject to the extension of its mandate by the Security Council in November 2023 in pursuance of paragraph 2 of resolution 2675 (2023). The Panel of Experts on Yemen, which is comprised of five experts, operates under the direction of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140(2014).

- 2. The recommended candidates should possess a minimum of Ten years of progressively responsible experience, with a minimum of three years of filed experience, in the below mentioned relevant areas of expertise and competence:
  - Arms,
  - Armed Group,
  - Finance.
  - International Humanitarian Law,
  - Regional Issues
- 3. The selection process will include an interview and other assessment methods to evaluate candidates, suitability. Sanctions experts are selected on the basis of demonstrated expertise in the relevant area of work, experience and educational background, with due regard to equitable geographic representation and gender balance. English and French are the working languages of the United Nation's Secretariat. For the above mentioned positions, fluency in English is required; knowledge of Arabic is an advantage. Appointment duration is in accordance with the mandate of the expert panel established by the Security Council. Experts are hired as consultants in line with the United Nation's administrative instruction concerning consultants and individual contractors (ST/Al/2023/4).
