SUBJECT: - TRAINING COURSE ON MARITIME SAFETY MANAGEMENT TO BE CONDUCTED IN PERSON IN SINGAPORE FROM 11 TO 15 AUGUST 2025 UNDER THE JAPAN SINGAPORE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME FOR THE 21ST CENTURY JSPP21

The Economic Affairs Division vide its O.M No.4(18) SEA/SINGAPORE/2025 dated 23rd April, 2025 has informed that the Government of Singapore and Japan has invited nominations for the above (**Fully Funded**) training course. Eligibility Criteria:

- Be Permanent Government employee (BS-17 and above) from this division.
- Mid-to-Senior level government officials who are working in port and maritime-related roles;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective:


- This in-person course is conducted under the auspices of the Japan-Singapore Partnership Programme for the 21st Century (JSPP21). This course aims to share the experience of Singapore and Japan in maritime safety management.

Moreover, all officers proceeding on foreign trainings have been directed to submit a 1000-word post-visit report upon return to EAD.

Note:- "In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress, may need not apply".
