# Subject:- BILATERAL SEMINAR ON PAKISTAN ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND CROSS-BORDER E-COMMERCE TRAINING (20 SLOTS)

The Economic Affairs Division vide its O.M No.6(3)EA/CHINA-II/2025 dated 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 states that Government of People's Republic of China has offered subject bilateral training course for Officers of the Government of Pakistan. The Chinese side has further informed that candidates cannot be withdrawn once nominated. The Government of Pakistan will not be liable to bear any cost. The detail of the program is at (Annex-I). The candidate will follow code of conduct (Annex-II). The requisite general requirements are as under:-

#### **Eligibility** Criteria:

- Officers (BPS-17 & above) of this Division most relevant to the training program.
- Proficiency in English.
- Maximum age limit is 50 years for BS-20 & above, and 45 years for BS 17-19.
- · Contract Employees are not eligible.

### **Documents Required:**

- Application Form with personal signature and photo (Original & Copy)
- Information Form with personal signature and photo (Original & Copy)
- Copy of Passport at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages
- Foreign Physical Examination Form with personal photo (Original & Copy)
- No criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate attested by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, if not visited China within 5 years
- FTC Proforma
- Copy of CNIC

No Objection Certificate (Provide within two days after selection)

2. Note:- "In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress, may need not apply".

E-commerce Research Center, the Shandong E-commerce Promotion Association, and the Shandong Cross-border E-commerce Association; and leading cross-border e-commerce platform enterprises including Amazon, Alibaba, iFLYTEK Co. Ltd., and Inspur Group and other companies. We have held multiple cross-border e-commerce training sessions at home and abroad and amassed a great wealth training experience.

This seminar is primarily for professionals in cross-border e-commerce and AI related fields from Pakistani government, academia, and businesses. The training contents include: 1. Introduction to China's national conditions; 2. China's cross-border e-commerce policies and "Belt and Road" cooperation opportunities; 3. AI basic theories and algorithmic applications; 4. Cross-border e-commerce compliance and customs clearance and intellectual property rights protection; 5. Application of AI in the operation of cross-border e-commerce platforms; 6. Al-driven cross-border e-commerce data analysis; 7. Cross-border Electronic Payment Systems and Risk Management; 8. Collaborative Optimization of Intelligent Logistics and Supply Chain; 9. Application of AI in Customer Service and User Experience; 10. Cross-border Live Streaming and Overseas Short Video Operation; 11. Construction of Independent Cross-border E-commerce Websites and SEO Optimization; 12. Analysis of the Full-custodial and Semi-custodial Models in Cross-border E-commerce, etc. This seminar will combine lectures, discussions, and site visits, and take participants to Hefei City of Anhui Province and Jinan City of Shandong Province. iHefei City is an important administrative center and commercial port in China's Jianghuai region, an advanced manufacturing base in central China, a regional science and technology innovation highland, and a national science and technology innovation pilot city. During their stay in Hefei, participants will visit the iFLYTEK Co. Ltd., Anhui (Shushan) Cross-border E-commerce Industrial Park, and other sites. Jinan has been officially approved by the State Council as a pivotal central city in the Yellow River Basin, a national historical and cultural city, a comprehensive national transportation hub, an advanced manufacturing base and a commercial and logistics center in northern China, and a regional sci-tech innovation center. During their stay in Jinan, participants will visit the Inspur Group, the Artificial Intelligence Incubation Base of Qilu Software Park and other sites. Qingdao, where the seminar will be held, is a national separately listed city and an important central city along the coast, and is the host of major international events and political and economic summits such as the Olympic Sailing Competition and the SCO Summit. During their stay in Qingdao, participants will visit the Haier COSMOPlat Industrial Internet Ecological Park, Qingdao Beauty Online New Economy Industrial Park and other places, and hold discussions. The seminar seeks to enable participants to gain insights into China's achievements in cross-border e-commerce development and AI technological innovation, learn from China's advanced experience, explore cooperation opportunities in depth, and promote the further development of friendly relations between the two countries in a limited period of time. Note: There may be adjustments in visiting cities according to actual situation.

# CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Adhere to the laws of the People's Republic of China and the relevant regulations outlined in the relevant seminar / training.
- 2. While the Chinese government upholds the freedom of religion, it is important to note that foreigners are prohibited from distributing religious propaganda material or engaging in activities that aim to recruit followers.
- 3. In case of an emergency, please promptly inform the staff for immediate assistance.
- 4. Please ensure the safety of your personal belongings and consider storing them in the hotel if needed.
- 5. If you have any specific dietary requirements, kindly inform the staff as soon as possible.
- 6. When visiting scenic spots and historical sites, please be attentive to signs indicating that photography is not allowed.
- 7. Please observe Chinese laws and Regulations during your stay. Especially the norms of "sexual harassment" can be different from your country's. Please avoid inappropriate and undesirable situations, which can lead to the termination of your program and draw legal consequences. Acts, conversation, correspondence, emails, gestures that can be construed as harassment must be strictly avoided.
- 8. You are not allowed to work, because you receive living allowance from China and the purpose of your stay in China is to engage in study / research.
- 9. Universally courtesy and politeness costs nothing and only earn friends. It is always beneficial to be courteous and polite. Politeness is not a sign of weakness. It shows good breeding, education and upbringing.
- 10. Female colleagues must be respected. They are fellow officers. Some very basic things shall be considered while interacting with the female colleagues:
  - Generally, as a mark of respect, one should stand when a female enters a room.
  - Personal space should be respected during conversation and a comfortable distance should be maintained.
  - Personal remarks on their dress and appearance should be avoided.
  - Loose language or inappropriate terms should not be used.
  - Inappropriate jokes should not be cracked.

- Hand gestures universally deemed obscene should not be made.
- Staring should be strictly avoided.
- Situations that make female colleagues uncomfortable should be avoided.
- While talking to a female, hands should never be placed in trousers pockets.
- Personal questions should never be asked (age, height, weight, marital status etc).
- Ordinarily, men should open the door for women.
- Females should always precede a male while entering a room.
- Door of a car should be opened for a female colleague.
- 11. Psychological harassment is against Chinese norms, that shall strictly be avoided:
  - a. Persistent, unjustified and unnecessary negative attacks on personal or professional performance;
  - b. Manipulation of an employee's personal or professional reputation by rumor, gossip or ridicule;
  - c. Offensive comments or behavior relating to the ethnic origin, physical characteristics or religion of an individual;
  - d. Exclusion or continued isolation from professional activities;
- 12. Social media ethics ought to be adhered to with responsibility.
